

No weapons. No exceptions.

- No tasers
- No firearms
- No chemical sprays (Mace, etc)
- A pocket knife or multi tool is permitted barring it doesn't involve a previous function.

Children greater than two years apart may NOT share a tent unless they are family. Example parents or siblings as long as the tent is exclusive to family.

No electronic devices for youth.

- No cell phones
- No tablets
- No portable gaming devices
- Portable audio players (not containing a camera) can be an exception but they must stay in their tent.

Each child should bring:

- Weather appropriate clothing
- Comfortable shoes (backup shoes recommend)
- A change of clothing
- An appropriate water container such as a canteen, camelback, etc that can be carried on a hike and contain enough water for a hike.
- A small day pack
- A pack lunch for the first day to put in their backpack
- A personal medkit
- A flashlight
