Permanent (adjective)

- lasting or intended to last or remain unchanged indefinitely.
- Synonyms
Lasting, enduring, Indefinite, perpetual, continuing

 - Freedom of Speech
- (Mark 8:27-33)



Permanent Perfection

Products of Permanent Perfection:

2- A *New and Living Way* (v. 20)

- Old Testament
- Death, Death, Death

New - Stark Contrast with *Living*

But Jesus answered them, saying, “The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified. Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.”

- John 12:23-24 (NKJV)

Products of Permanent Perfection:

3- High Priest in the House (v. 21)

“Hasn’t He always been in the House of God?” - Colossians 1, Micah 5

He has not always been Priest.



Permanent Perfection

Products of Permanent Perfection:

4- Drawing Near (v. 22) (Twice in Matthew 4, Once in Matthew 5)

- True Heart
- Full Assurance of Faith
- Hearts Sprinkled (Cleansed)

(Language of priests)

- Purity
